The undersigned, desiring to organize a non-profit corporation under the provisions of the Alabama Non-Profit corporation Act (Act Number 578, Regular Session, 1955; Chapter 10. Section 203 through 263, of Title 10 Code of Alabama, 1940), with all the rights powers, privileges of a corporation organized under said Sections of said Code and under the Constitution and Laws of the State of Alabama, hereby make and file these articles of incorporation as required by the provisions of the said Alabama Non-Profit Corporation Act, and certify as follows:

FIRST

The name of the corporation shall be "The Cove at Fox Hollow" Homeowner's Association. This corporation shall be a part of the larger corporation that will include all the communities of Fox Hollow.

SECOND

The period for which the corporation shall exist shall be perpetual; however, its directors may terminate its existence pursuant to the provisions pertaining to the dissolution of the corporation hereinafter set out.

THIRD

The purposes for which it is formed are in general to maintain and increase the beauty, quality and value of "The Cove at Fox Hollow", thereby making the entire Fox Hollow Subdivision a premier residential community, while increasing the quality of life of the families who reside therein, and specifically, but not in limitation of the foregoing, to receive, hold, manage, use and dispose of properties of all kinds, real and/or personal.

Without in any way limiting the foregoing stated purposes, and in addition to those powers specifically granted by The Alabama Non-Profit Corporation Act, the corporation shall have the following powers:

(a) To acquire, accept, administer and disburse moneys and properties of every kind, character and description, or to hold in trust moneys and properties, devised, granted, bequeathed, donated or otherwise given the corporation, in such manner as it deems appropriate for the purpose of furthering the objects and activities of the Association, subject to any restrictions imposed or conditions applying to any assets thus accepted.

(b) Powers granted hereunder shall be limited to those necessary to the accomplishment of the purposes of the organization

FOURTH

The corporation shall have no members or classes of members initially. However, the by-laws may provide for members to include homeowners in Fox Hollow Subdivision whose dues are not in arrears.

FIFTH

There shall be five (5) directors of the corporation. The following described persons and officers shall, during their terms of office, be members of the Board of Directors and shall serve Ex Officio:

(a) The President of the Corporation

(b) Vice-President of the Corporation

(c) Secretary of the Corporation

(d) Treasurer of the Corporation

(e) Past President of the Corporation

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The number of members of the Board of Directors may be increased or decreased by amendment of the By-Laws. Such additional directors shall be elected by and all directors shall serve at the pleasure of the members of the Association. Upon death or resignation of any member of the Board of Directors automatically holding office as such director, the person assuming his duties shall become a member of the Board. Upon the death or resignation of any other director as may be later provided for in the By-Laws, in the event that any member named herein should fail, refuse, or be unable to serve, the remaining board members shall have power to fill the vacancy. Directors once elected or appointed shall exercise full powers until their successor shall be elected or appointed. Directors shall be elected for a term of one (1) year.

SIXTH

The Board of Directors shall have the following power which may be exercised by them by a majority vote of those directors present at any duly called meeting attended by a majority of the directors:

(a) To enact such rules and By-Laws for the government of the corporation as the performance of its functions shall require, including but not limited to, providing for officers and committees to which any part of the powers herein granted may be delegated, as they deem necessary, from time to time, and their terms of office, provided that no such rules and By-Laws shall be interpreted so as to conflict with any present or future provisions of the Constitution or Laws of the State of Alabama, or with any of the provisions of these Articles of Incorporation, or with any provision of the laws of the United States of America under which contributions to the corporation may be considered as deductible on income, gift or state tax returns of the donor.

- (b) To terminate the existence of this corporation, but upon such other termination or dissolution, all funds and assets, after the deduction there from of any expenses of dissolution and liquidation, shall be paid over to the City of Pell City of the State of Alabama, if such be in existence and, at the time, be approved as an organization to which gifts are deductible on income, gift, and estate tax returns, and if not, to the State of Alabama for the purpose of beautifying and maintaining the Alabama State Parks.
- (c) To designate from time to time at least three of the members of the Board of Directors to serve as an Executive Committee of the Board, with such powers and authority as may be granted it by the Board of Directors.
- (d) To designate a member or members to serve on the Board of Directors of the master Fox Hollow Home Owners association.

<u>SEVENTH</u>

The corporation shall not be authorized to issue shares of stock. There shall be no personal or individual liability of any character of any director or officer for any debts or obligations of the corporation.

EIGHTH

The developer shall appoint the members of the Board of Directors until the association is turned over to the Homeowners. Membership on this board will not be limited to homeowners of The Cove.
